Subject: Meeting request 14-15 January: delegated act currently under scrutiny by the European Parliament

Dear XXX MEP,

I am reaching out to you on behalf of the Titanium Dioxide Manufacturers Association (TDMA) to request a short meeting with you, or someone from your team, on 14 or 15 January in Strasbourg to discuss the possible classification of titanium dioxide.

Specifically, we would like to provide you with a briefing regarding a delegated act ([2019/2843 DEA](#)) which is currently under scrutiny by the European Parliament which proposes to classify a number of substances, including titanium dioxide, under the EU's classification and labelling (CLP) Regulation. This delegated act was already discussed in the ENVI Committee in December, but we understand the issue may come back in the plenary at the end of the month and we would like to offer an overview of the file.

Titanium dioxide is the world's most used white pigment and it is critical to the manufacture of a wide range of products, including paints, coatings, plastics and paper. Given that titanium dioxide is an essential raw material for several industries, it is an issue which could have significant impacts on the EU circular economy, SMEs and competitiveness.
